

SCOTTSDALE HISTORY & FACTS

The history of Scottsdale began in 1888 when Winfield Scott, an Army Chaplain, purchased 640 acres of land in what is now the downtown Scottsdale area. Scott believed that the land had potential for a farming operations because of the climate and access to irrigation. Many people from the East and Midwest decided to follow him. The area saw a population boom between 1908 and 1933 and drew many educated and cultured people, including prominent businessmen, artists, and architects like Frank Lloyd Wright. The town was officially incorporated in 1951, and the population grew from 2,000 to over 202,000 over the next fifty years. Scottsdale has a truly unique culture which has drawn people from all over the world to move to and visit.





GOLFING




